Dates: 20 to 22 December 2019

Venue: Theewater Sports Club, Theewaterskloof Dam, Villiersdorp, Western Cape

Organising Authority: Theewater Sports Club (TSC) in association with the International Mirror Class Association under the authority and sanction of South African Sailing.

NOTICE OF RACE

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NOR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules Of Sailing*.
- 1.2 **The South African Sailing prescriptions for National and Regional Championships** will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Mirror Class.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the on-line entry form on the SA Sailing website under the "What's On" page, "Mirror National Championship 2019" (<https://www.sailing.org.za/events/50623/>) and sending the proof of payment of the entry fee of R550 by 24h00 on 11th December 2019 to:

- 2.3 Late entries will be accepted until close of registration at 12h00 on the 20th December 2019 at a late-entry fee of R750.

2.4 All competitors shall be members in good standing of SAS and of a yacht club affiliated to and in good standing with SAS (or their equivalent in the case of non-South Africans) and of the International Mirror Class of SA.

2.5 Proof of such membership shall be presented at registration.

3 ADVERTISING

3.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20.

3.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority in accordance with Regulation 20. [DP]

4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Registration: 20th December 2019, from 09h00 to 12h00.

4.2 Equipment inspection and event measurement as required: 20th December 2019, from 09h00 to 12h00.

4.3 Dates of racing: Friday 20th December 2019,
Saturday 21st December 2019, and
Sunday 22nd December 2019.

4.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 12h55, and each day thereafter at 09h55.

4.5 A maximum of 12 races are scheduled.

4.6 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15h00.

5 MEASUREMENT

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on the Mirror Class website no later than 09h00 on 19th December 2019 and will be available at registration.

7 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be according to the diagrams in the Sailing Instructions, which will include the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed and, the side on which each mark is to be left.

8 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with a yellow flag. [DP]

9 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

In terms of the SA Sailing requirements for National Championships, South African Sailing medals will be presented as follows:

Yachts finishing at least 2 races	Medal
10 to 14 yachts	Gold
15 to 19 yachts	Gold and Silver
20 or more yachts	Gold, Silver and Bronze

Class Trophies and Prizes will be awarded by the International Mirror Class Association of SA.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of R2,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
